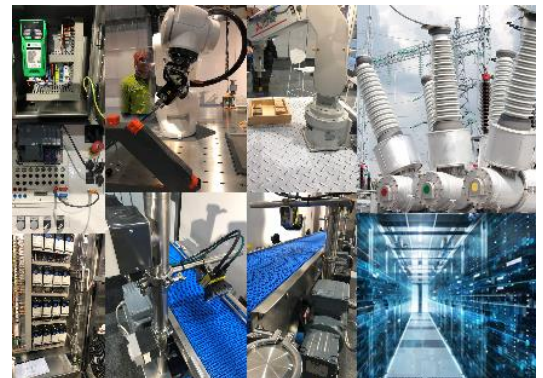

Discussion will aim to focus on.

1. The potential cohort and number of cohorts required to sustain a most suitable qualification or qualifications that would have the greatest potential for TAFE to gear up for, provided funding was available.
2. Identifying the most suitable qualification or qualifications that could be deployed that is broad enough to create a class – for instance the [UEE62122](#) - *Advanced Diploma of Engineering Technology – Electrical* (this qualification has no prerequisite requirements and maybe useful as an interim measure pending a fix to the Electrotechnology Training Package).
3. Obtain industry and stakeholder support for acceptance in initiating the UEE62122 program.
4. Undertake a concerted promotional campaign to encourage more learners to undertake the program.
5. Aim for a target date startup of the program of first semester next or ensuing year depending on funding and resource availability.

Unfortunately, there is not going to be a change to the existing arrangement for another couple of years given changes to the National VET system now under way. A new energy Job Skills Council (JSC) is being created.
